DASDTAPE Command

- DASDTAPE QUERY reports on TAPEDISK usage
- DASDTAPE LIST reports on existing DASDtape TAPE files
- DASDTAPE EXPIRE expires an existing DASDtape TAPE file
- DASDTAPE STATUS reports on mounted DASDtape TAPE files




Dynamic Erase of Expired DASDtapes

- Expired DASDtape TAPE files
 - erased automatically when space is needed
 - only erased if the tape is not in a catalog

Backup Job Status Information Screen

- Redesigned
- Displays more information
- PF8 (Forward) and PF7 (Backward) scroll through streams



QUERY BACKUPS Command

Displays progress of running backups

XRESTORE Command

- End users
 - Restore SFS files using a line mode command
 - Restore SFS files to a different target than the source
 - Find a 'needle in a haystack'
- System administrators
 - Restore SFS file spaces that were deleted
- Can also restore files from CMS minidisks



Restore File Selection Screen

- Toggled PF10
- PF10 (Select All) adds r next to all listed files
- PF10 (Deselect All) clears all selections added through PF10 (Select All)



Automated Shutdown Support

- Enabled to receive shutdown signals from CP
- END command is invoked

- QUERY STORAGE command

- Default trace table size 256K (was 64K)
- VMBMCOPY version update
